## Simply Charlotte Mason <br> Subject Cards

1. Choose the cards with the days of the week that you do your schooling. Lay them out in a row in order.
2. Write any outside commitments/activities on blank cards and lay them below the days on which they regularly occur.
3. Determine how many days per week you want to do each subject and select that many cards. Set the others aside. (See below for helpful suggestions.)
4. Lay your selected subject cards below the days of the week. Try to distribute them evenly across the week, keeping in mind your outside commitments and not overloading any one particular day.
5. Focus on one day at a time and arrange the cards in an order that uses different parts of the brain in sequence.
6. Once you're happy with your schedule layout, take a picture of it for easy reference. Write it on a paper or enter it into a spreadsheet, then post it where everyone can see the schedule.

## Suggested Grades and Frequencies

Use only as many cards as you need; you don't have to use them all. Here are some suggestions for a starting point, but make your schedule work for your family.
